What is the 2019 Summer Mission Experience?

This summer, we are taking a step outward and joining God's kingdom work elsewhere in the U.S.A. We will be working with youth from across the nation to share the gospel in word and good work as we roof, paint, and complete general repair projects for the underserved in Gallup, NM. Some teens will also be able to serve one of the least reached people groups in America as we serve the Navajo people on reservation.

Where are we going & where are we staying?

We will be traveling to Gallup, NM. We will stay at the First Baptist Church in Gallup or in the Middle School located nearby.

Plan on arriving at FCC at 5:30am on Monday, June 24, and bring a sack lunch for the journey. We will travel by van to Gallup, NM. Expect us back on Saturday, June 29 by 5pm. We will be sure to keep parents updated via text.

How much will it cost?

\$410 a person; \$60 non-refundable deposit due by March 31, 2019. Remainder due by June 23.

Participants can reduce their financial burden by helping with the Easter Breakfast Fundraiser, support raising, or requesting a scholarship. Depending on need, other fundraising opportunities may be pursued.

Please make checks payable to Fellowship Community Church.

The cost of the trip covers lodging, meals at the project, project preparation materials, a T-shirt, secondary accident insurance, program materials, experienced leadership at the project, pre-project supplies and logistics, transportation (rental, fuel), and lunch on the way home. The deposit is non-refundable because FCC must pay a \$60 non-refundable deposit upon registering a participant.

Youth who have completed the 6th grade through youth who are in college, and their parents, are welcome to join us on this trip! ****Please note the training dates, however, as all participants must attend the pre-trip meetings.**

World Changers Construction projects provide the avenue to connect with a local community in order to meet a physical need through home repair. Students spend approximately eight hours a day on ministry sites doing construction or other tasks helpful to homeowners. Students are trained and encouraged to seek opportunities for sharing the gospel with homeowners or other community residents. We hope that students leave a construction project equipped beyond how to do physical labor. We want students to leave with a desire to serve others and equipped for a lifestyle of gospel sharing.
