DRIVE-IN WORSHIP SERVICE

We've got great news, friends! For the past several months, we haven't been able to come together as a community to worship on Sunday mornings, but with summer weather upon us and restrictions easing up, we are excited to provide an opportunity for just that. Beginning Sunday, June 21, and continuing as long as necessary, we want to invite you and your family to join us in the north FCC parking lot at 10:30 a.m. for a time of worship together. Pop the trunk and sit in the back or pull out some lawn chairs, and our service will be broadcast over the radio, 98.1FM. Finally, we can sing with others! We'll also have a children's recommendation, so bring that wifi-enabled device just in case. We will need to maintain appropriate distancing (so you'll have to keep that 6 foot distance from other families), but it's a nice segue to when we can finally be together. We will continue to have the worship service available to view on YouTube each Sunday at 9:00 a.m.

So we'll see you Sunday, June 21 and just so we're clear, here's what to expect and what we're asking from our families when they come:

- Come to the south parking lot of FCC by 10:30 a.m.
- Park every other spot. Cones will help you know which spots to park in.
- After parking, feel free to stay in your car; or pop open the trunk, pull out some lawn chairs, and sit near your vehicle with the radio up. Tune your radio to 98.1FM.
- The service will be broadcast over the radio and elements will be live when possible.
- Please maintain 6ft distance from other families, as possible.
- Please wear masks.
- And if you can't make it, know that the worship service will still be available on YouTube Sunday mornings at 9am.
