

History of Thanksgiving

Thanksgiving can be traced back to the Pilgrims and the Wampanoag Indians, who celebrated what is now known as the "First Thanksgiving" in 1621. It was celebrated sporadically until 1789 when President George Washington proclaimed Thursday, November 26, 1789 as a day of "public thanksgiving and prayer"

following a resolution of Congress. He called it a day to be devoted to "the service of that great and glorious Being who is the beneficent Author of all the good that was, that is, or that will be."

However, we credit Abraham Lincoln for declaring Thanksgiving a federal holiday in 1863 during the American Civil War. He called it a national day of "Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the

Heavens," to be celebrated on the last Thursday in November.
